130th GENERAL ASSEMBLY HOUSE BILL 468 **EFFECTIVE MARCH 23, 2015**

Significant changes to several sections of the Revised Code (R.C.) have been made that impact Motor Vehicle Salvage Dealers, Salvage Motor Vehicle Auctions, Salvage Motor Vehicle Pools, and Used Motor Vehicle Dealers, as licensed under R.C. Chapters 4517 and 4738. It is strongly encouraged that you review the entire bill. Important changes include but are not limited to:

- All salvage certificates of title will include in bold letters, **“SALVAGE MOTOR VEHICLE – PURSUANT TO R.C. 4738.01.”**
- Elimination of the issuance of Buyer Identification Cards for entrance into Salvage Motor Vehicle Auctions and Salvage Motor Vehicle Pools.
- Salvage Motor Vehicle Auctions and Salvage Motor Vehicle Pools shall only sell salvage motor vehicles to an “authorized purchaser” as defined in R.C. 4738.01(G) upon documented proof of any of the following licensed or authorized to do business:
 - Any person who has not purchased more than a total of five (5) salvage motor vehicles in the current calendar year.
 - Licensed Motor Vehicle Salvage Dealer
 - Licensed Junk Yard
 - Licensed Scrap Metal Processing Facility
 - Licensed Used Motor Vehicle Dealer
 - Authorized Salvage Dismantler or Automotive Recycler
 - Any of the above listed that are authorized to purchase salvage motor vehicles by another state, country, or jurisdiction.
- For every sale of a salvage motor vehicle, Salvage Motor Vehicle Auctions and Salvage Motor Vehicle Pools shall do all of the following:
 - Keep an electronic record of all sales of salvage motor vehicles as set forth in R.C. 4738.021(A)(1)
 - Obtain and keep a copy of valid identification as set forth in R.C. 4738.021(A)(2)
 - Obtain a signed declaration under penalty of perjury (form BMV 4315 may be used)
 - Out-of-country purchasers – stamp both sides of title “FOR EXPORT ONLY”
 - Upon development and implementation by the State of Ohio – send monthly information to a statewide database (date to be determined)
- Salvage Motor Vehicle Auctions and Salvage Motor Vehicle Pools may perform out-of-state inspections as set forth in R.C. 4505.061. (Log into www.OhioAutoDealers.com Online Services to access form BMV 3706.)
